

Typing Special Characters Using The International Keyboard

Please remember to type the characters in **exactly** as described in the chart!

<i>l'accent aigu</i> á, é, í, ó, ú	1. Press RIGHT Alt key and hold it down 2. Type a, e, or i, o, or u
<i>l'accent grave</i> à, è, ì, ò, ù	1. Press Apostrophe key (`) (<i>first key on the number line next to 1</i>) and let it go 2. Type a, e, i, o, or u
<i>l'accent circonflexe</i> â, ê, î, ô, û	1. Press Shift key and type 6 and let both go 2. Type a, e, i, o, or u
<i>la cèdille</i> ç	1. Press RIGHT Alt and hold it down 2. Type comma key (,) - third key from right on bottom row
¿	1. Press RIGHT Alt and hold it down 2. Type question mark (?) key
ã, õ Ã, Õ	1. Press Shift key and hold it down 2. Press the Tilde Key (~) (<i>first key on top row next to 1</i>) and let both keys go 3. Type a, o <u>To type an uppercase Ã, Õ:</u> 1. Press Shift key and hold it down 2. Press the Tilde Key (~) (<i>first key on top row next to 1</i>) and hold both keys together 3. Type a, o
ñ, N	1. Press RIGHT Alt and hold it down 2. Type n or N
ä, Ä	1. Press RIGHT Alt and hold it down 2. Type q or Q
ö, Ö	1. Press RIGHT Alt and hold it down 2. Type p or P
ü, Ü	1. Press RIGHT Alt and hold it down 2. Type y or Y
